

EXTREME PATAGONIA

Day 1: Private Transfer to Las Torres Hostería – Trekking to Seron Camp (4 hrs.) going through to the famous Daisy Prairie. Tent night, meals prepared by the guides.

Day 2: Trekking of approximation to Mameluko Passage (6 hrs.), where there is a view of Dickson Glacier and the Mountains of the Ice Cap Field – Night at the High Camp, meals prepared by the guides.

Day 3: This day we will go through the “Mameluko” Passage, here the Silence Valley gives us a great view of the west side of Torres Del Paine and of two of the greatest mountains in the park, “Escudo” and “Fortaleza” Hills (8 hrs.). Night at the Japanese Camp, meals prepared by the guides.

Day 4: After a good breakfast and to clear the camp we will walk to “Las Torres” Campsite (1 hr.), from here we visit the viewpoint of the towers (2 hrs.) and then down to the Chileno Refuge (2 hrs.). This is an ideal place to rest and recover energy, besides we have an excellent view. Night and meals prepared by the guides.

Day 5: This day we will have a soft trekking to the Bader Camp; it is located in the entrance of Bader Valley (5 hrs). This is a quiet place with a cottage built by climbers that come to Patagonia to conquest its peak. Night at the Camp, Meals prepared by the guides.

Day 6 : Trekking day among to the Bader Valley, walking through the valley we will be surround the East Horn to get into the valley, with a possibility to see the Hoja (Leaf), Máscara (Mask) and Espada (Sword) Hills and also the big wall of the South Tower and the hanging Glacier on its base. This is one of the wildest places in the Park. - Tent night at Bader Camp, dinner and breakfast prepared by the guide/assistants.

Day 7: Back at “Los Cuernos” Refuge (2 hrs) and we will walk to the Italian Camp, here we will visit the French Glacier and finish our day in the “Paine Grande” Refuge (5 hrs). - Night, dinner and breakfast at the Refuge.

Day 8: Horse Ride from the “Paine Grande” Refuge to the Paine Administration (3 hrs.) - Private Transport to the Serrano Camping (7 km.) - Tent Night- Lamb Barbecue - Wines – Night at the Serrano Camping.

Day 9: Our guides give us an instruction about kayaking, direction and security. We will row constantly with the Paine Mountain Range behind our back (2 hrs). With a special maneuver we will evade the Serrano waterfall. If the weather allows we will row to the mouth of Tyndall River, navigating constantly with an excellent view of the Paine Mountain Range (4 hrs). Night at the “Río Tyndall” Camp - Meals prepared by the guides.

Day 10: After an excellent breakfast we will row up Tyndall River to get to Tyndall Lake, about (4 kms.) (1 Hr.) We will have the possibility to get closer to the Tyndall Glacier or stop in a small cove to walk and get another perspective of the glacier. This is an excellent place to have lunch. Back along the Tyndall River and reaching Serrano River up to the "Pekín Guerrero" Ranch (4 hrs.) Night at the Ranch – Meals provided by the guides.

Day 11: After to say goodbye to Mr. Pekín, we will row down River Serrano (2 hrs.) observed by lenga and cypress forests, getting closer to Balmaceda hill and the marvelous sight of Serrano Glacier up to the mouth of River Serrano and the last few miles over the "Última Esperanza" Fjord towards Puerto Toro- Visit to Serrano Glacier - Connection with the boat back to Puerto Natales city through the "Última Esperanza" Fjord – Arrival to Puerto Natales city – END OF THE PROGRAM.
